**Woven Together in Pandaemia, now in its third year as Covid-19 continues to make people cautious but also became away for people to meet virtually from further afield using Zoom.**



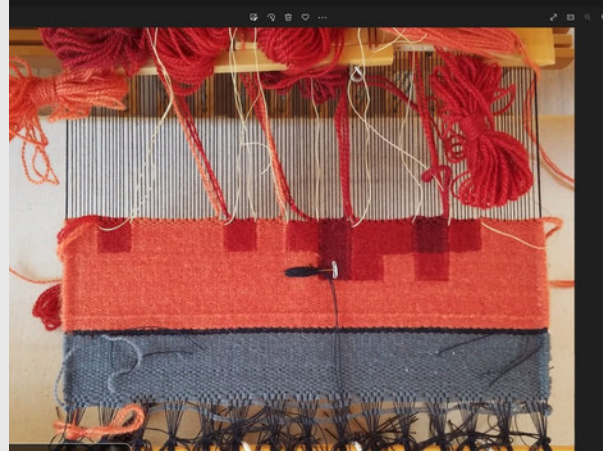
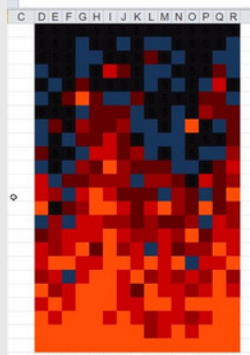

first in-person workshop since Covid lockdown began in 2020

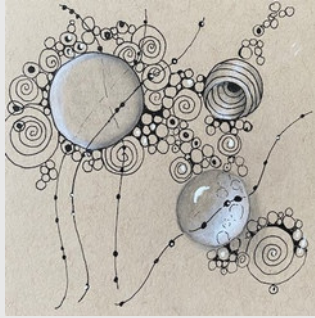
